2011 OUTSTANDING SUPERVISOR AWARD

Purpose

To recognize a Land Conservation Committee (LCC) supervisor who has provided strong and effective leadership in promoting resource conservation through their own actions and work in their community.

Eligibility

Nominees can be any individual who is an elected official serving and supporting the purpose and efforts of the county LCC.

Guidelines

Leadership, effectiveness and the nominee's efforts to demonstrate a commitment to conservation shall be important factors in judging this award. Length of service (except where those have been important factors in leadership and effectiveness) shall not be considered important criteria for this award. Nominations received without proper support/paperwork may not be eligible for an award.

Procedure

Entries should be submitted before **October 21, 2011** to WLWCA, 702 East Johnson Street, Madison, WI 53703. The WLWCA Awards Committee will randomly select counties who shall annually review and potentially select the winner of the WLWCA Outstanding Supervisor Award. Recognition of the State Award will be provided at the annual WLWCA Conference held December 8-9, 2011. The sponsoring county is responsible for travel and lodging expenses for the State Award Recipient; awards dinner banquet meal for the winner and one guest (if applicable) will be provided by WLWCA (two maximum).
