

Options for Joint Organizational Elections and Structure

(State & Area Levels)

← Trend: Organization of individuals with equal votes by **PERSON**

Trend: Organization of counties with equal votes by **COUNTY** →

1

All paid indiv. members elect LCC and LCD Reps./ two tier vote system (LCC/LCD)

- Open nominations for one LCC and one LCD State BOD Rep. from each Area Association
- All paid Area LCD staff vote for an Area LCD Representative
- All paid Area LCC members vote for Area LCC Rep.
- Notes: Areas are designated by state association
- State Assoc. staff organize elections
- Existence and function of Area BOD left up to each Area

2

Area BOD elect LCC Rep. /LCD Rep. elected by all paid area LCD members

- Area BOD elected same as #5
- State BOD elected same as #4 with open nominations for LCC & LCD Reps.
- Area LCC BOD elects LCC Rep. to State BOD
- All paid LCD Area members elect LCD Rep. to State BOD

3

Same as #4 plus two "at large" Area members would be voted to State BOD

- Area BOD elected same as #5
- State BOD elected same as #4 except two more "at large" LCC/LCD Reps. are voted to State BOD
- Note: Results in 4 State BOD Reps. from each Area Association

4

Area BOD vote for State Reps: Open Area Nominations from all LCC/LCD paid members

- Area BOD elected same as #5
- State BOD Rep. elected same as #5 except open nominations allowed from all paid Area LCC & LCD members for State BOD Reps.
- Note: Area BOD still elects 2 State BOD Reps – 1 LCC & 1 LCD by same process as #5

Recommended

5

Area BOD vote for State reps from Area BOD Membership only

- Area BOD made up of one LCC & LCD Rep. from each county in Area
- LCC appoints LCC Rep. to Area BOD
- CC appoints LCD Rep. to Area BOD
- LCC Area BOD Reps. elect LCC State BOD Rep.
- LCD Area BOD Reps. elect LCD State BOD Rep.
- (SE Area model – presented at 2/17/11 meeting)

CC's Merge with WLWCA - rest of WALCE remains as a professional improvement organization

- Same as #5 except that only County Cons are eligible for Area & State BOD positions and committees
- WALCE would remain purely a professional improvement organization
- Option: Could allow appointment of non-County Cons to committees
