Certification in one of the following areas or the ability to obtain given certification within 1-year of hire and maintain certification thereafter during employment: Certified Crop Advisor (CCA) certification from the American Society of Agronomy (ASA), State Soil Tester Certification (CST), and Private On-site Wastewater Treatment Systems (POWTS) Inspector Certification. Experience with Geographic Information Systems (GIS), Global Positioning Systems (GPS), SNAPplus, RUSLE2, CAD, or other related software and equipment.
